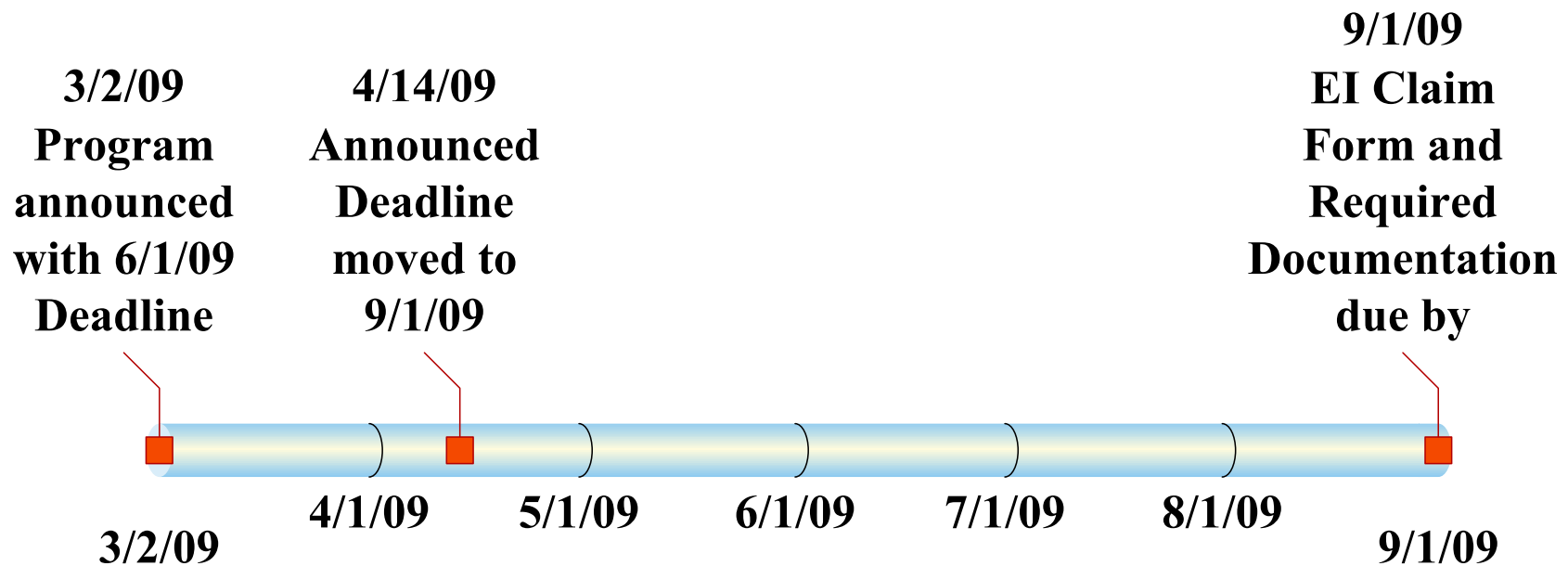

IMPORTANT REMINDERS ON MI PAYMENTS

- 1) Review report provided by CA most recently on 8/28/09 to verify current status of each claimant.**
- 2) Review payment reconciliation report posted by CA on 9/11/09 to verify Interim and Fixed Payment amounts previously issued.**
- 3) Notify CA Contact if there are any discrepancies with Claims Status or Payment reports no later than 9/18/09. This is the last opportunity to correct any discrepancies before the Final Payment.**

IMPORTANT REMINDERS ON MI PAYMENTS

- 4) **Special Marker Claimants Electing Special Review will not be paid at the end of the third quarter.**
- 5) **No separate MI **Interim** Payments will be issued in September. Instead, these will be included in the Final Payment.**

FINAL MI POINT VALUE

- 1) The current MI Point Value is projected to be between \$1,860 and \$1,870.**
- 2) This is only 2%-3% less than the value originally predicted.**
- 3) Approximately 3,125 more MI claimants passed Gates and are receiving Points than originally projected.**
- 4) Approximately 117,525 additional MI Points are being compensated than originally projected.**
